

PRIVACY POLICY OF THE "FrontUniverse" WEBSITE

§1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. The controller of personal data collected via the Website is Damian Idczak, conducting business activity under the business name Damian Idczak, with its registered office at: 95-080 Tuszyn, ul. Nieras Leśny 26a. NIP 7282893112 REGON 540577030.
2. Contact with the Controller is possible via e-mail at: contact@frontuniverse.com and by phone number: 538306653.
3. Personal data is processed in accordance with the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR).

§2. PURPOSE, SCOPE AND LEGAL BASIS FOR DATA PROCESSING

1. The Controller processes personal data in order to handle inquiries directed via the contact form available on the Website and for the purpose of potentially establishing cooperation.
2. The following data is collected in the contact form: e-mail address, telephone number, and the content of the message.
3. The legal basis for data processing is:
 - taking steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract (Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR);
 - the legitimate interest of the Controller, consisting of communication with website users (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR).
4. Providing data is voluntary, but necessary to send an inquiry via the form.

§3. DATA RECIPIENTS AND STORAGE PERIOD

1. Personal data may be transferred to entities processing them on behalf of the Controller, including hosting service providers and software providers used to operate the website.
2. Data will be stored for the period necessary to handle the inquiry, and then for the limitation period for potential claims (generally 3 years for claims related to conducting business activity or 6 years under general rules).

§4. USER RIGHTS

1. The data subject has the right to request access to their data, their rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, the right to data portability, and the right to object to their processing.
2. In the event of a breach of the provisions of the GDPR, the user has the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.

§5. COOKIES

1. The Website uses "cookies" necessary for its proper functioning.
2. Session cookies (deleted after closing the browser) and persistent cookies (stored for a specified time) are used.

3. The User has the ability to independently manage cookies from the level of the web browser settings.
